

Afghanistan Wuwei Bridge



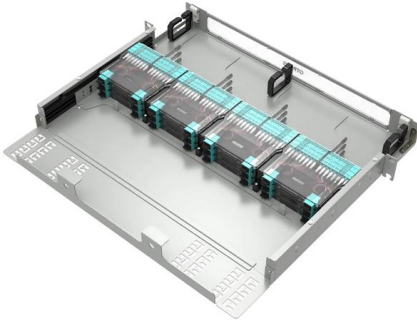


Overview

The bridge has an eerily Orwellian name — the Friendship Bridge — and a storied history in Afghanistan's wars. Some 15,000 Red Army soldiers lost their lives and more than a million Afghans were killed in a Cold War confrontation between a Soviet-backed government in Kabul and mujahideen fighters armed by the West and Islamic neighbours.

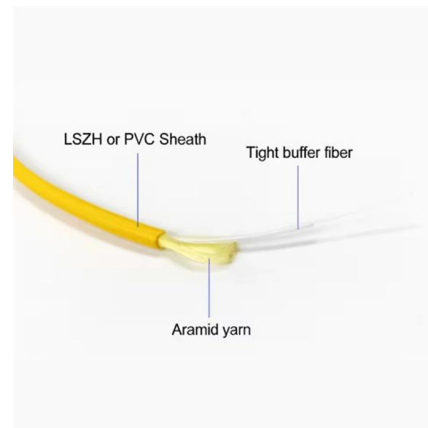

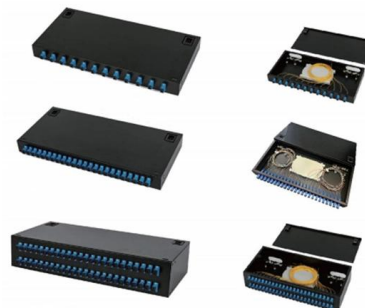

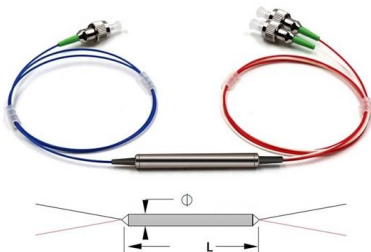


Afghanistan-Uzbekistan Friendship Bridge
