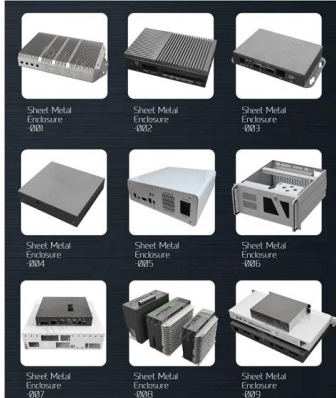


Overview

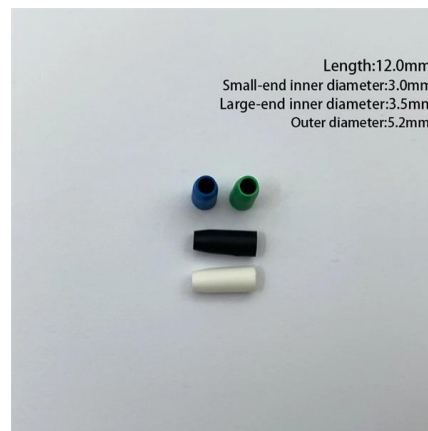

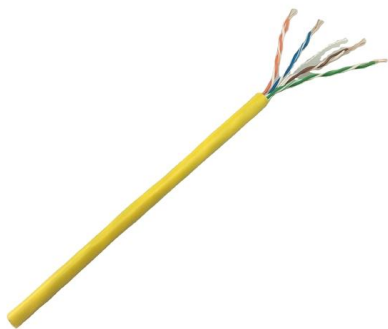

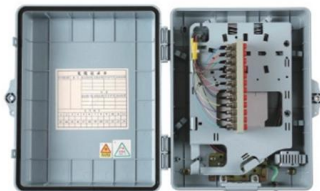
