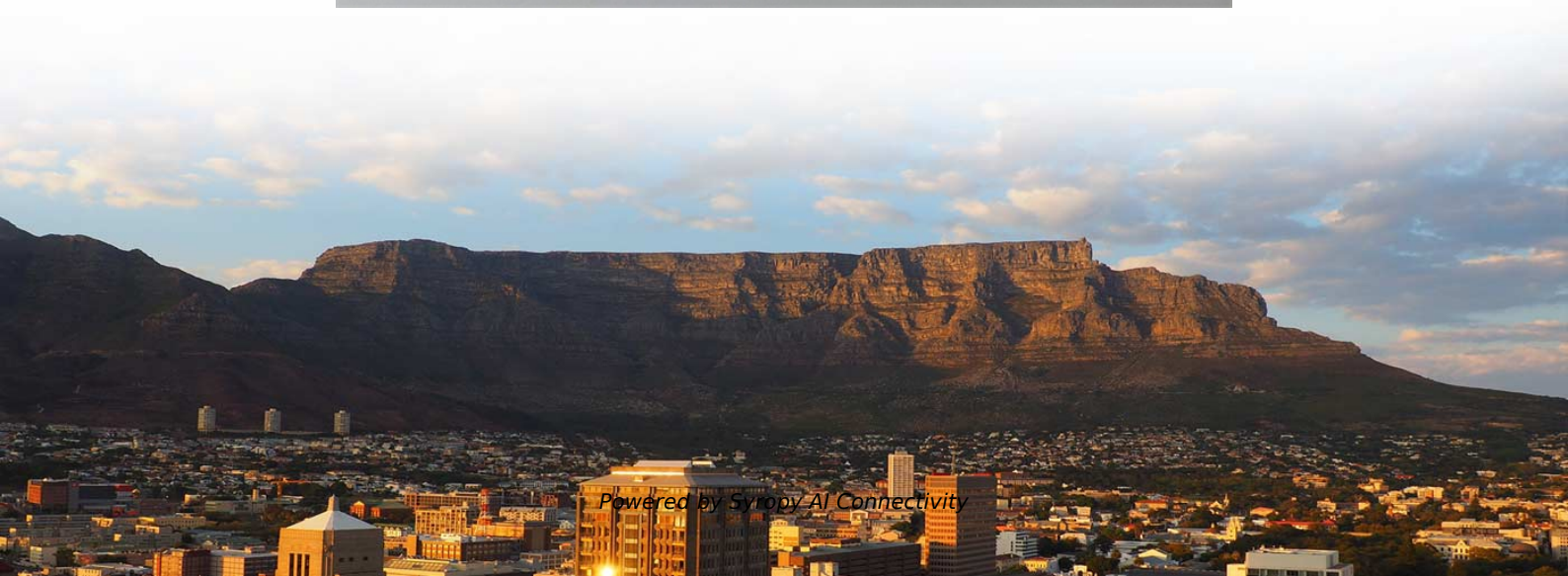
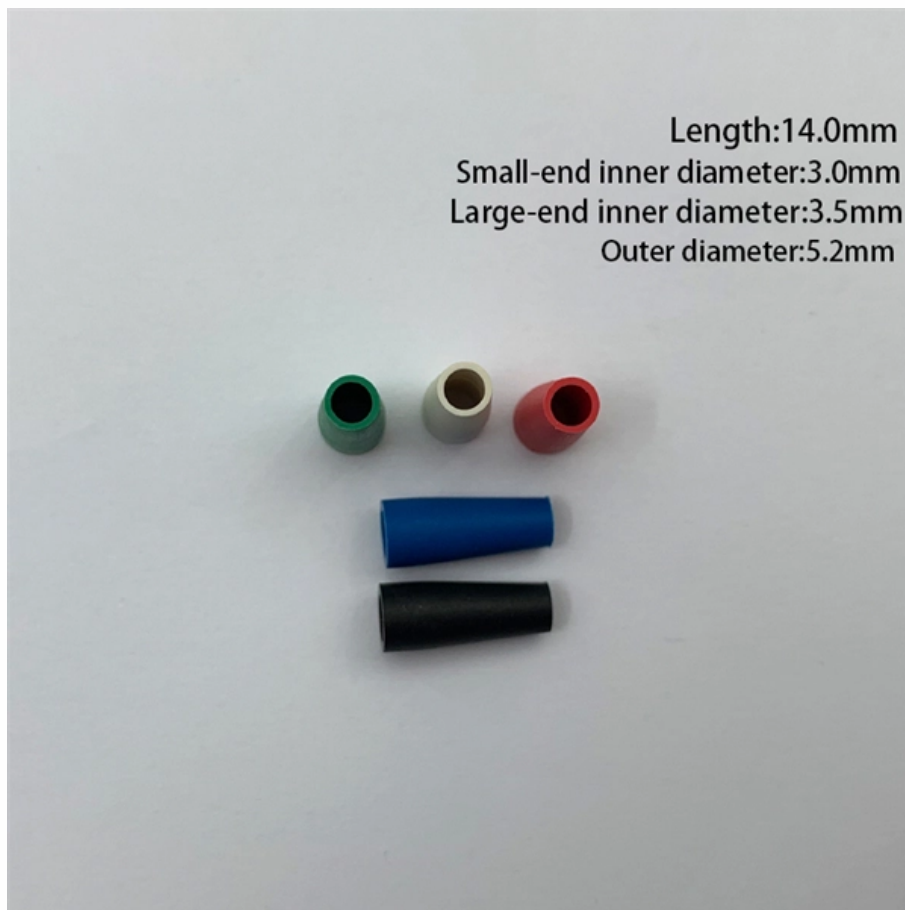


Arc Isolation Plate of Secondary Distribution Box



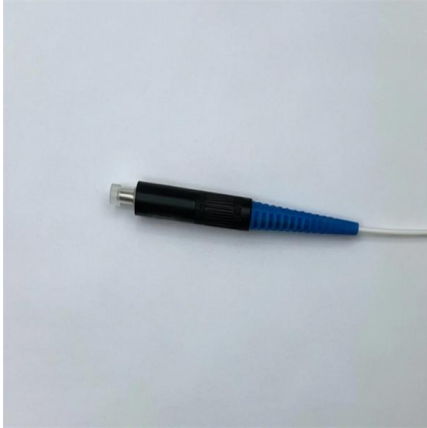


Overview

The isolating vault prevents tools and other objects from inadvertently entering the incoming zone and causing a catastrophic release of arc energy. Under normal service conditions, the expected service life of gas-insulated switchgear 8DJH 36 is at least 35 years, probably 40 to 50 years, taking the tightness of the hermetically welded switchgear vessel into account.
