If the accidental arc occurs at the end of a busbar system, it is possible that it ignites from there on an earthed part of the low-voltage system and burns a hole in the outer shell.

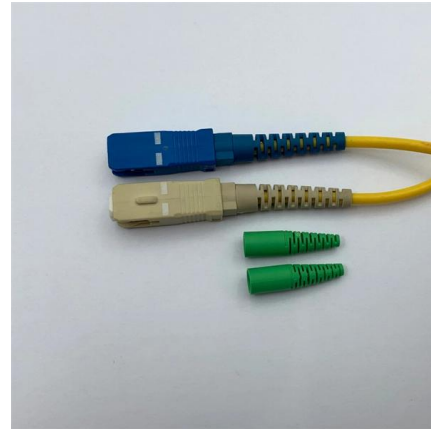
