How to Select the Right Cable Trough and Save Costs

Cable tray fill rate: Recommended $\leq 70\%$ (for heat dissipation and maintenance), meaning the net cross-sectional area of the cable tray must be $\geq$ (total cable cross-sectional area $\div 0.7$).
