

Chilean Telecom Optical Cable





Overview

Humboldt Cable is a planned fiber optic submarine communications cable that will connect Chile with Australia, becoming the first-ever link between South America and the Asia-Pacific region. As of June 2025, Google has invested between \$300 million and \$550 million in the project, while the Chilean government had committed \$25 million.
