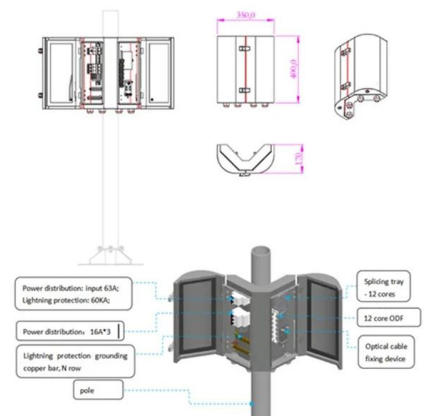

Core switches are defined as high-capacity switches located at the top of a cloud data center network, connecting aggregation switches and providing interfaces to wide area networks (WANs).

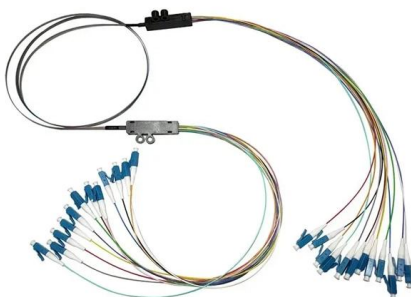
