# **Do network cabinet doors need to be grounded**





## Overview

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Each cabinet must be equipped with an earthing bar or a ground reference metal sheet. If you've ever found yourself scratching your head over whether that metal door on your distribution cabinet really needs a grounding wire, you're not alone. Bonding (or grounding) is a system of protective measures, which is implemented to prevent electric shocks when touching metal parts of energy-powered equipment. The following guidelines should be observed when grounding a cabinet: An unpainted earth reference plane or rail must be installed on the floor of the cabinet for the conventional reference potential. Grounding strip shall comply with EIA universal mounting hole spacing and mount to standard racks and cabinets.

The design of enclosures means that many elements, including the doors, are only mounted at particular points (using screws, welding, hinges, etc). This results in several gaps. Entry and exit of cables

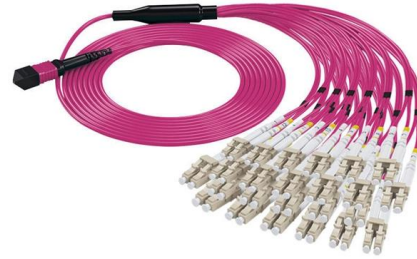

Flammable storage cabinets do not need to be grounded when they are used strictly for storage. Federal regulations under 29 CFR 1910.106 detail construction and capacity requirements

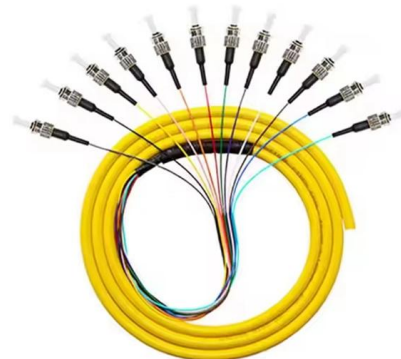

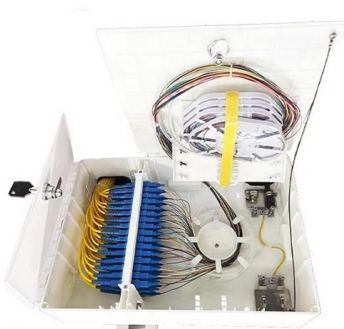
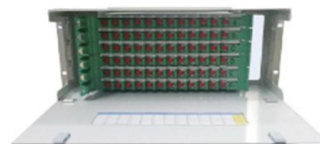
