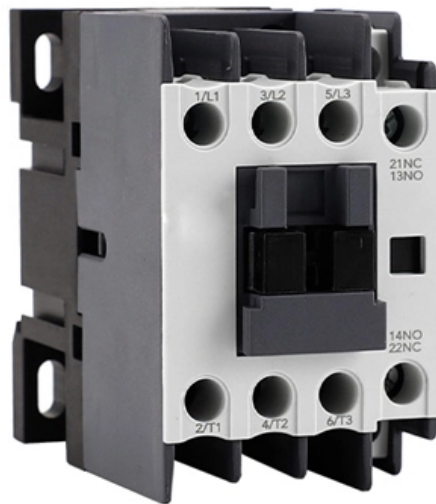


Do network server racks get hot

Modern servers generate substantial heat during normal operation, and this thermal output only increases as you add more equipment to your racks. Without adequate temperature control, servers can overheat, resulting in reduced efficiency and potential system failures. Maintaining 68°F–77°F (20°C–25°C) minimizes overheating risks while balancing cooling expenses. ASHRAE recommends this range for modern servers, though some operators push to 80°F (27°C) for. Efficient server rack cooling is the backbone of any well-functioning data center.
