5.1 The fiber optic fiber reel should be stored in its upright position in an area with a flat, solid surface during storage. Do not store the cable reel on its side against one of the flanges,

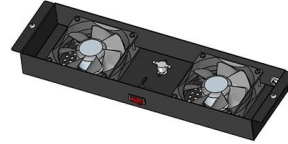

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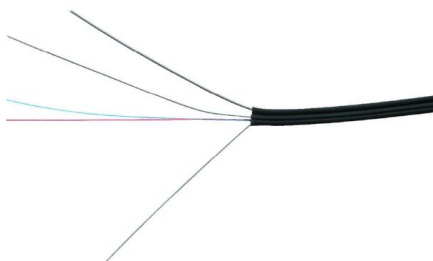
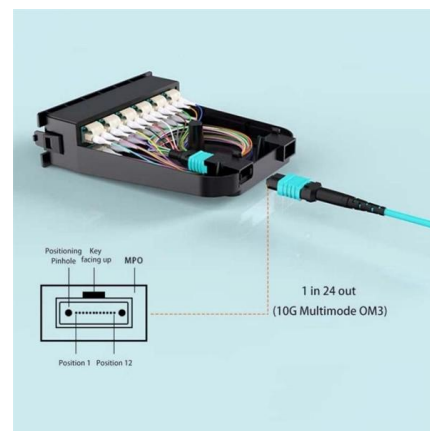
