It is comprised of a core and cladding (coating) that trap light, allowing light to travel long distances. The technology of fiber optics was first identified in the 1870's when John Tyndall noticed light from a gas street lamp was captured in a stream of water coming from a full barrel of water positioned beneath the light.

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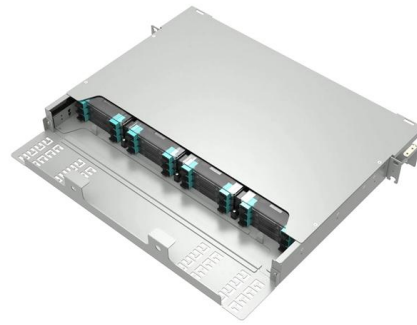

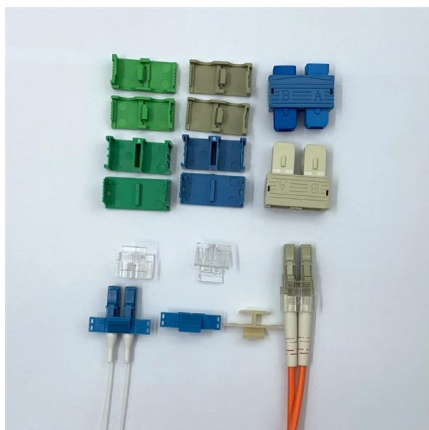
