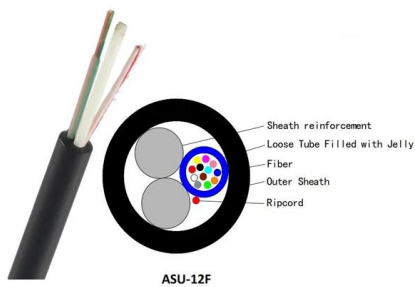
SECTION 5.6 GUIDELINES FOR FIBER OPTIC ROUTE

5.6.3.1.6 Fiber optic cable must not be installed within 5 feet (1.52 meters) of underground power or signal lines, unless suitably insulated. 5.6.3.1.7 If the fiber system is side-ignited within 30 feet (9.14 meters)

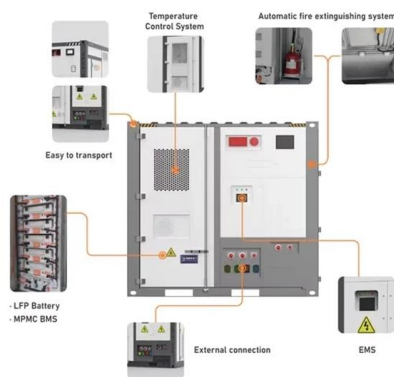
