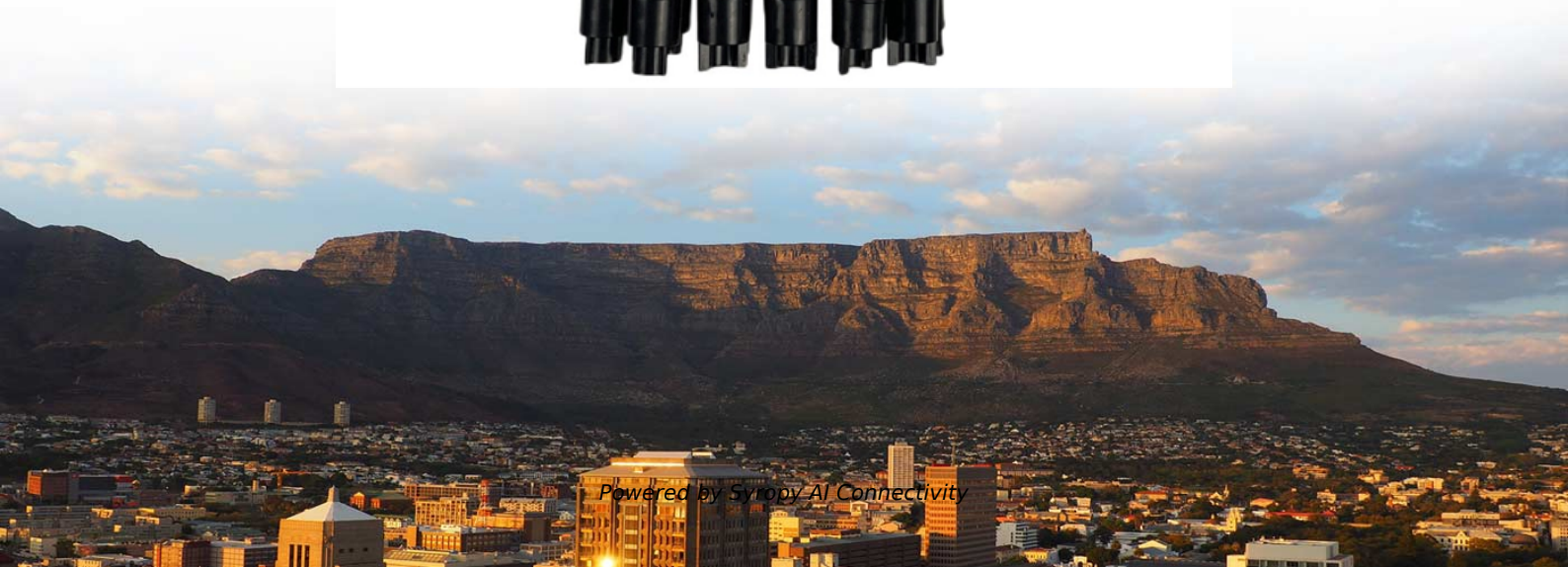


Fire prevention for electrical distribution boxes and equipment
