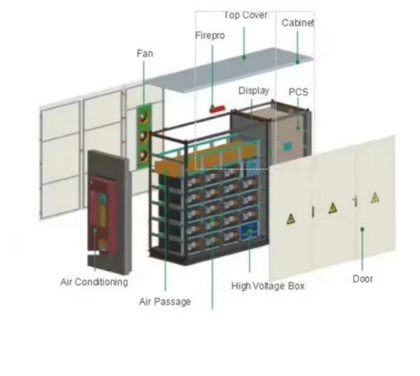
Guinea Backbone Network

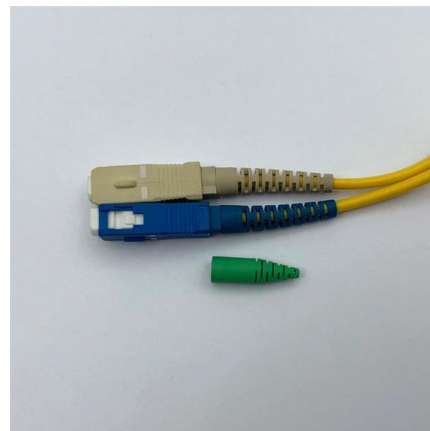

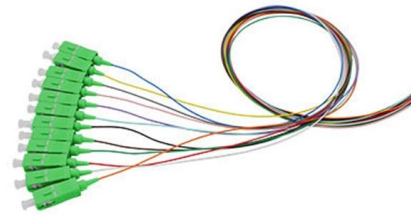

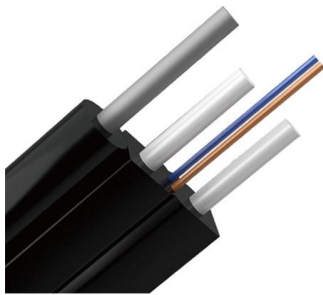
