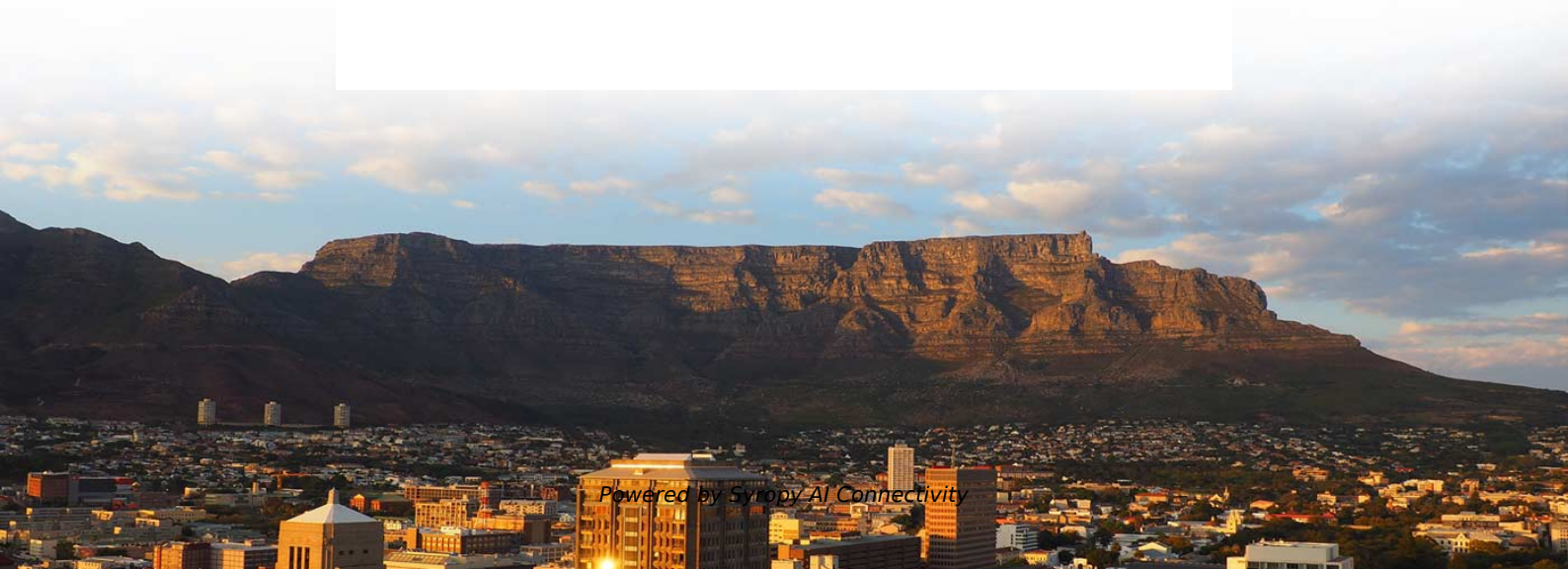


Household electrical distribution box with two switches on one line

This configuration uses a single incoming power source that must be distributed to both switching devices. 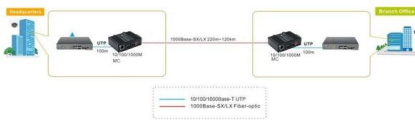

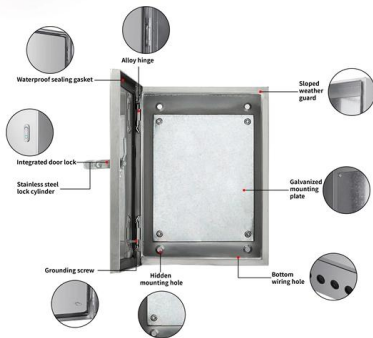
