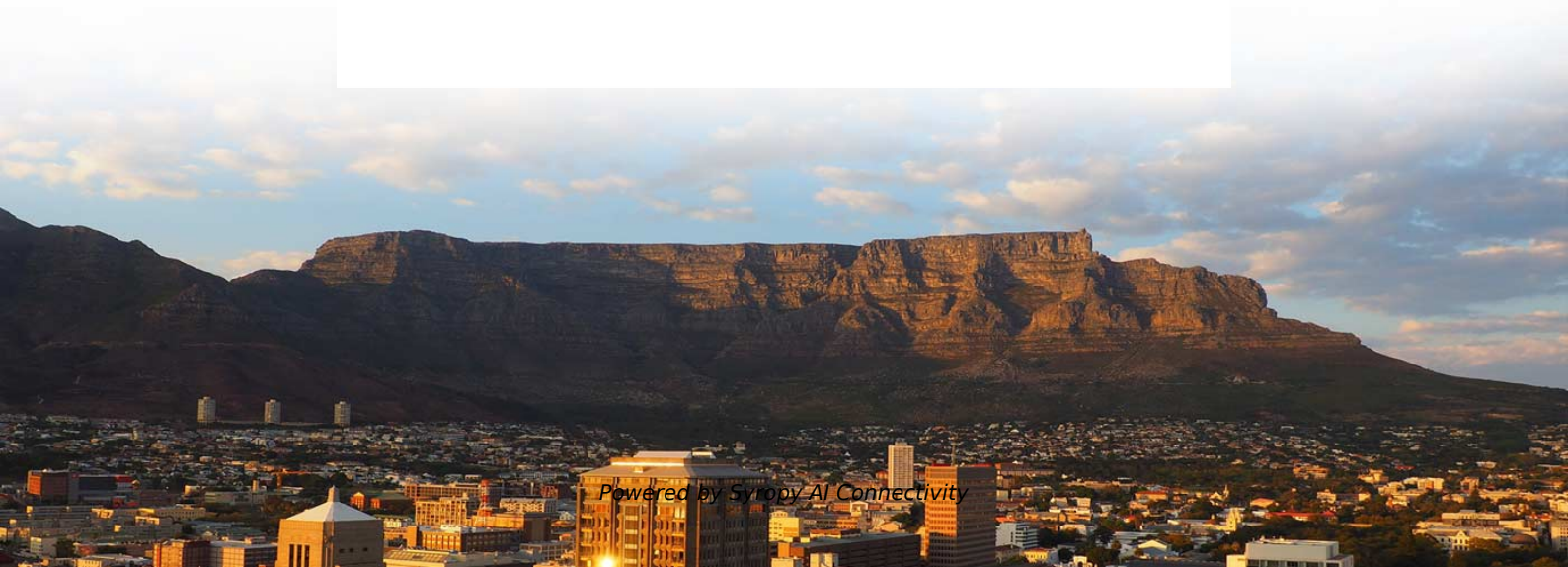

Ground an Electrical Panel: NEC Requirements

Install the Rod: Drive the $\{8\text{-foot}\}$ grounding rod into the earth near the panel (at least 6 feet from other electrodes). Connect the GEC: Run the correctly



Ground Rod in the Grounding System

Rod-type grounding electrodes should be spaced a minimum of 6 feet (1.8 m) apart or according to the manufacturer's installation instructions. Supplemental

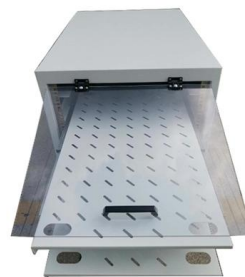

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

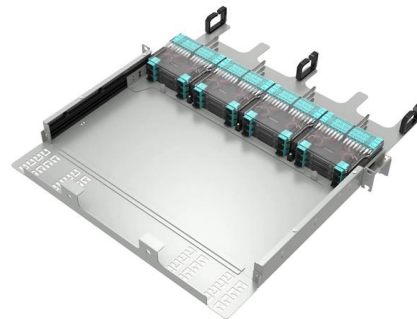
