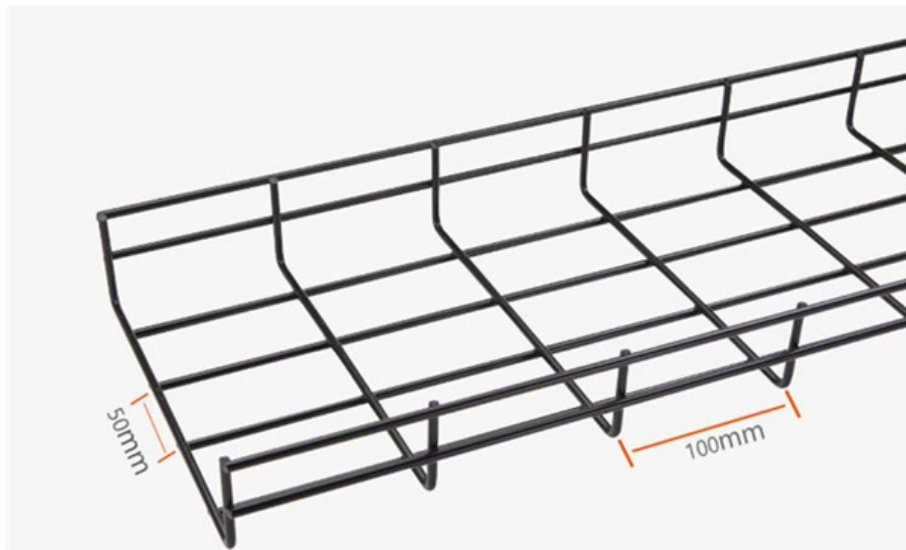
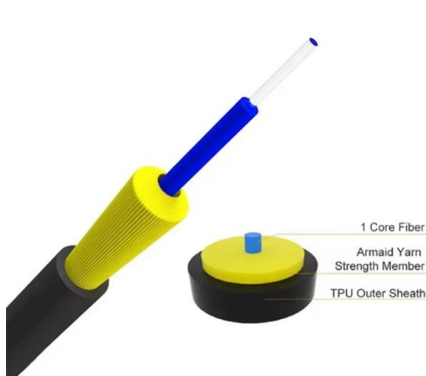

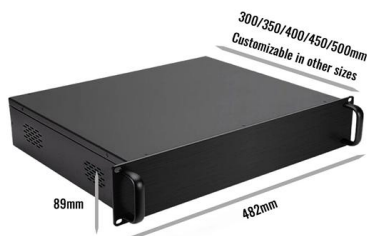


Optical Fiber Cold Splicing and Fusion Splicing

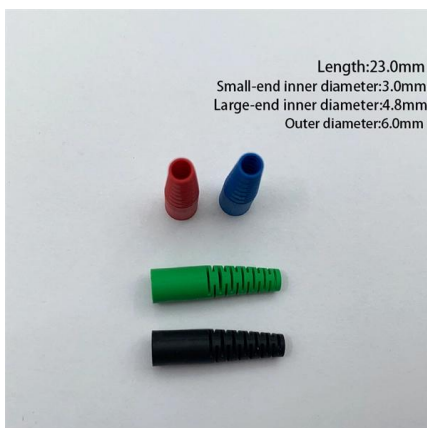

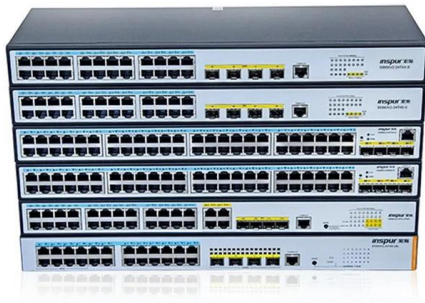

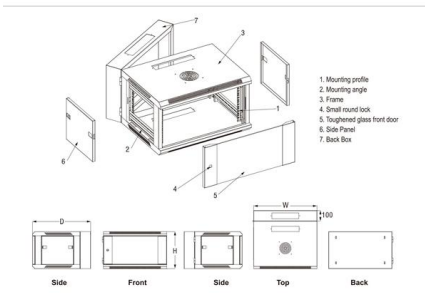
