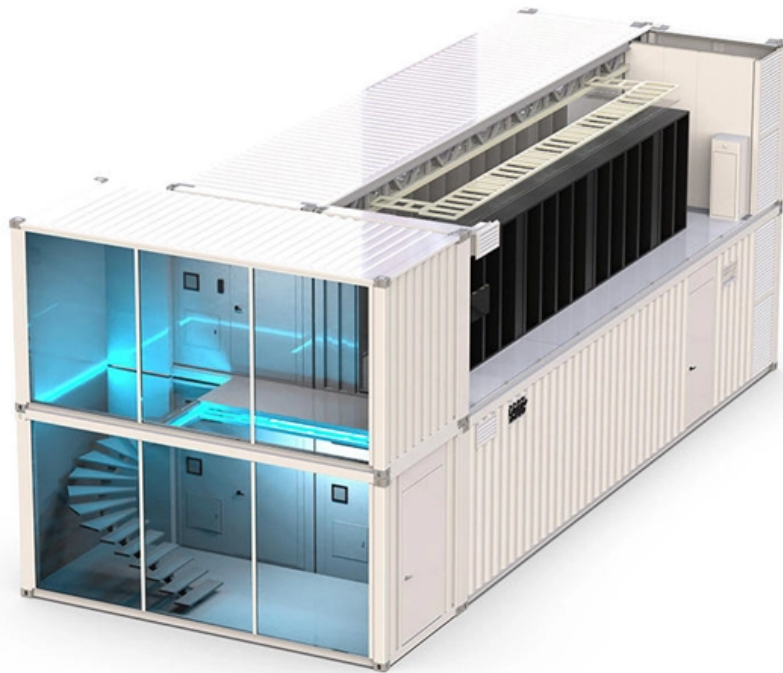

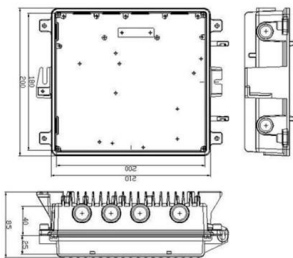

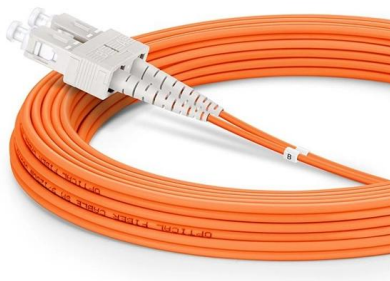
Optical Fiber Coating Stripping Skills For Fiber Optic Pigtails

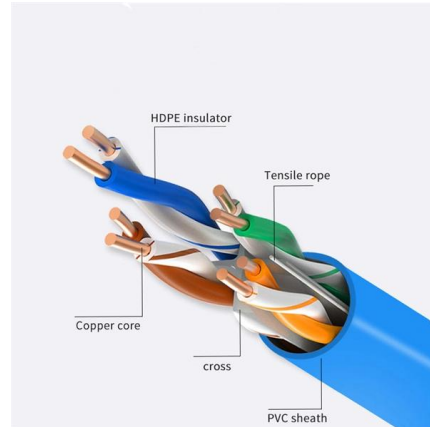

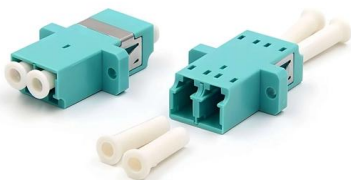

Before using the fiber, you should strip tight buffered fiber optic pigtail with tri-hole fiber stripper. If you do not remove all of the buffer coating, the fiber will not be able to be utilised in terminating fiber optic

The fiber coating may be mechanically stripped using a tool designed for such a purpose. Coating residue may be removed using a lint-free pad soaked with high purity alcohol.
