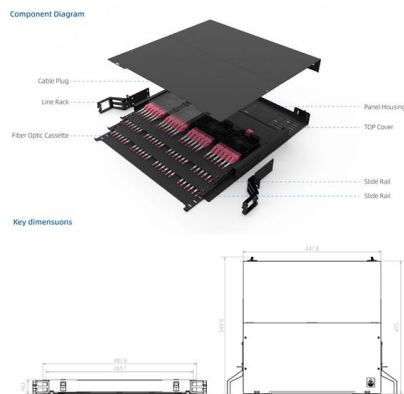
How to choose fiber optic pigtails?

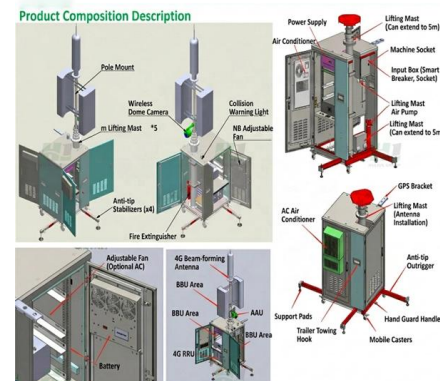

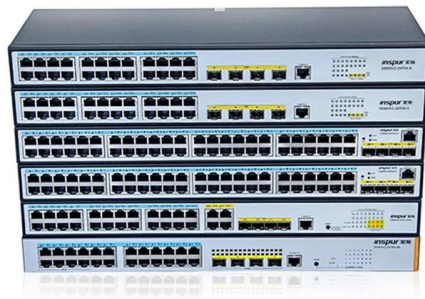
