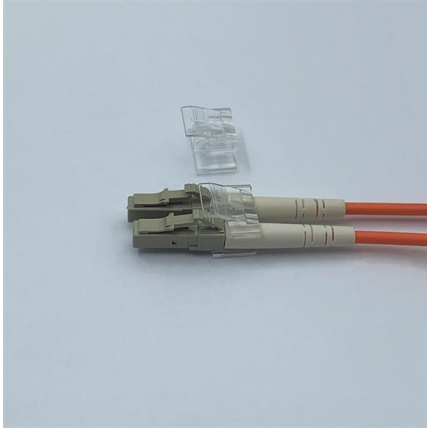

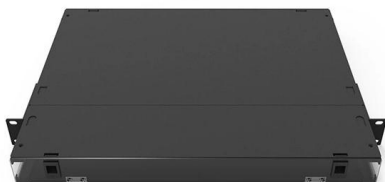


Removing and Installing Transceivers and Fiber-Optic Cables
