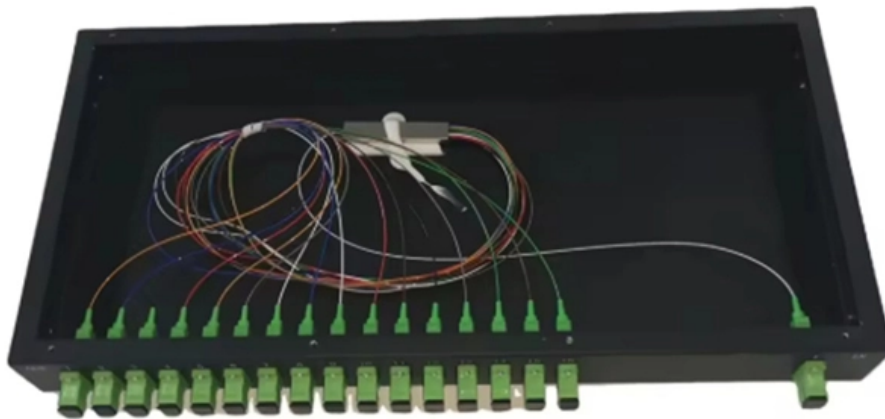


Indoor Color of Multimode Fiber Optics



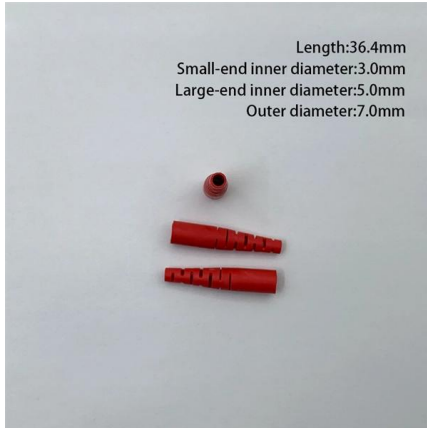


Overview

The most common standard for fiber optic color coding is the EIA/TIA-598-C standard, which identifies jacket colors (the outer jacket around each single-mode or multi-mode fiber), internal fiber color (the colors of the individual internal fibers), and connector color codes. WolonFiber's 12-Color Fiber Optic Pigtail Packs are manufactured strictly to the TIA-598-C standard with vibrant, easy-to-identify colors. Now there are revisions to the standard, but for our discussion, the ANSI/TIA-598-D-2 is the big addendum that deals with OM5. These are now mostly used in legacy networks or short links under 1 Gb/s or 10 Gb/s. For example, cable jacket color typically defines the fiber type, and can differ based on mode and performance level. 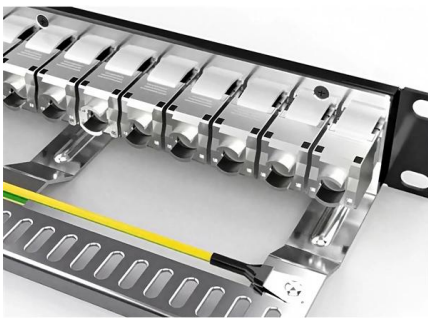

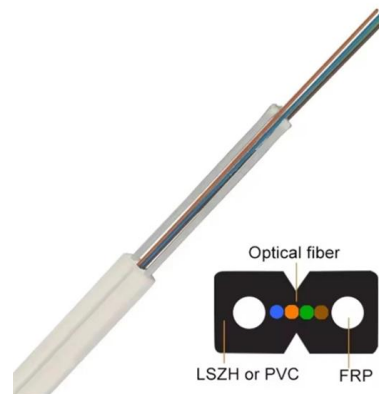

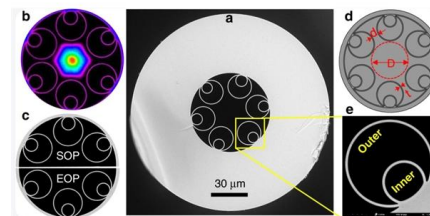
