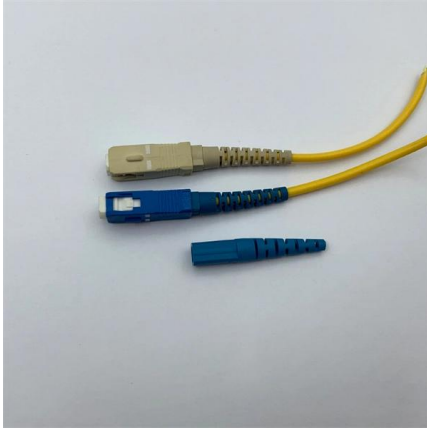


Overview
