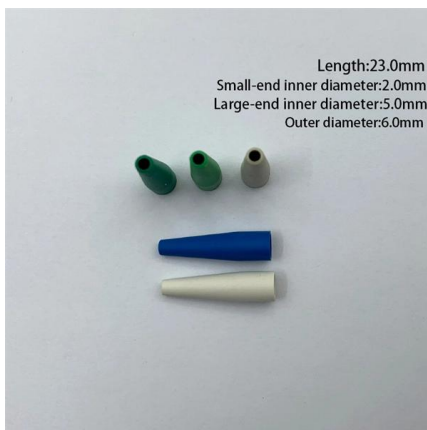

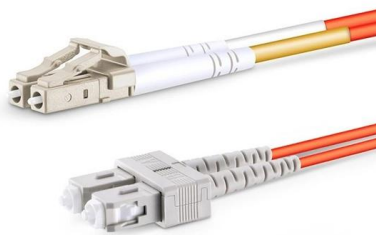

A solid green or orange light means that the service is up and running but is not being used. A red light or light (or if the light itself is off) usually means that a particular service is not working.

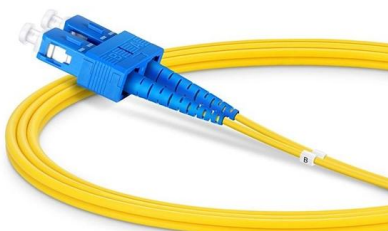

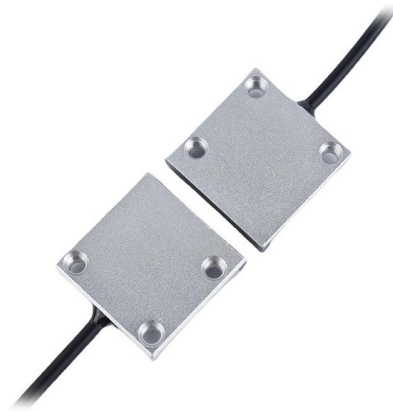

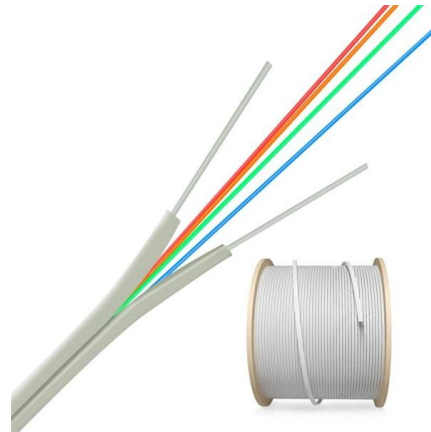
