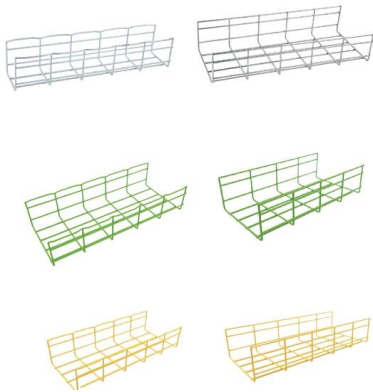


Overview

After termination and interconnection, two critical parameters come into play: Insertion Loss (IL) and Reflection or Return Loss (RL). DIAMOND SA has set a new benchmark in fiber optic connectivity with the development of ultra-low loss (ULL) connectors that further reduce the coupling losses caused by lateral and angular misalignment at the mating interface. The Ultra Low Loss connector expands optical power margin which can be turned to offset excess attenuation of improper installation or insufficient cleaning by reducing insertion loss when applying multi-connection points, over 3 to 5, in between transmitter and receiver.



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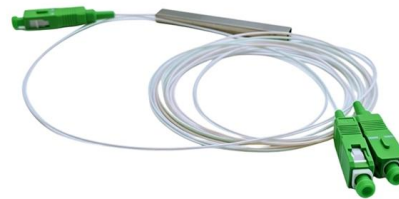

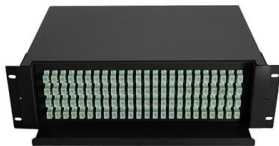

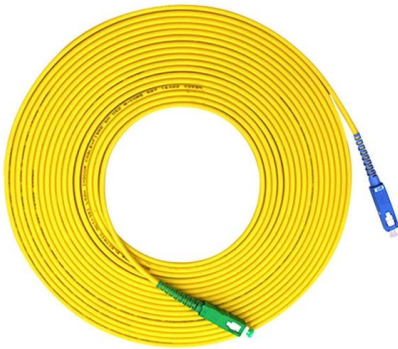
