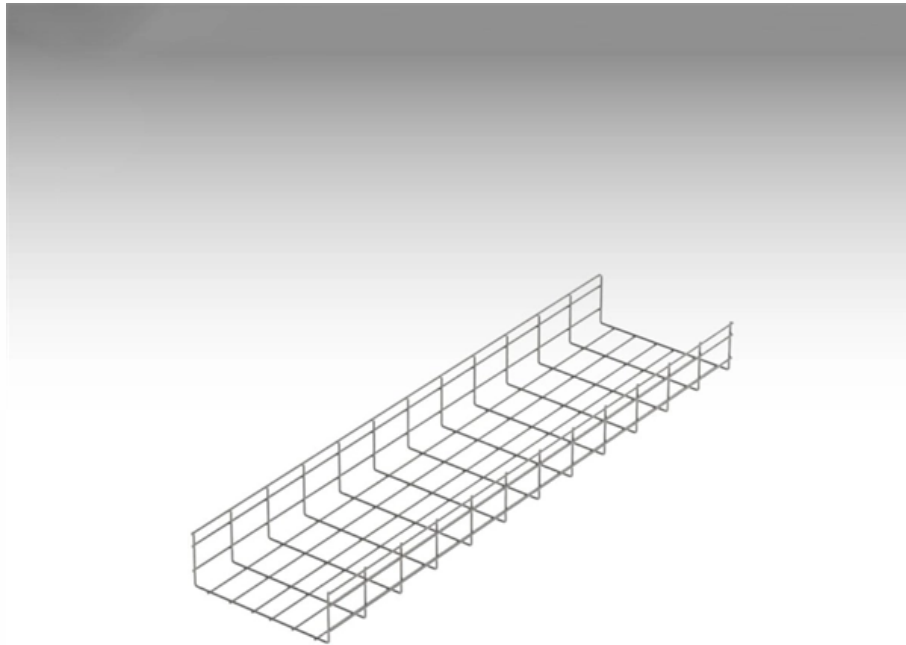

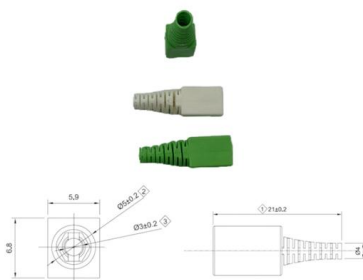
Overview

The fastest way to test a fluorescent tube is with a multimeter set to continuity mode. 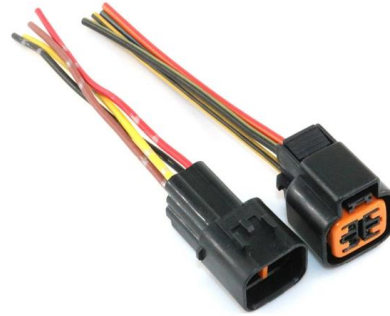
