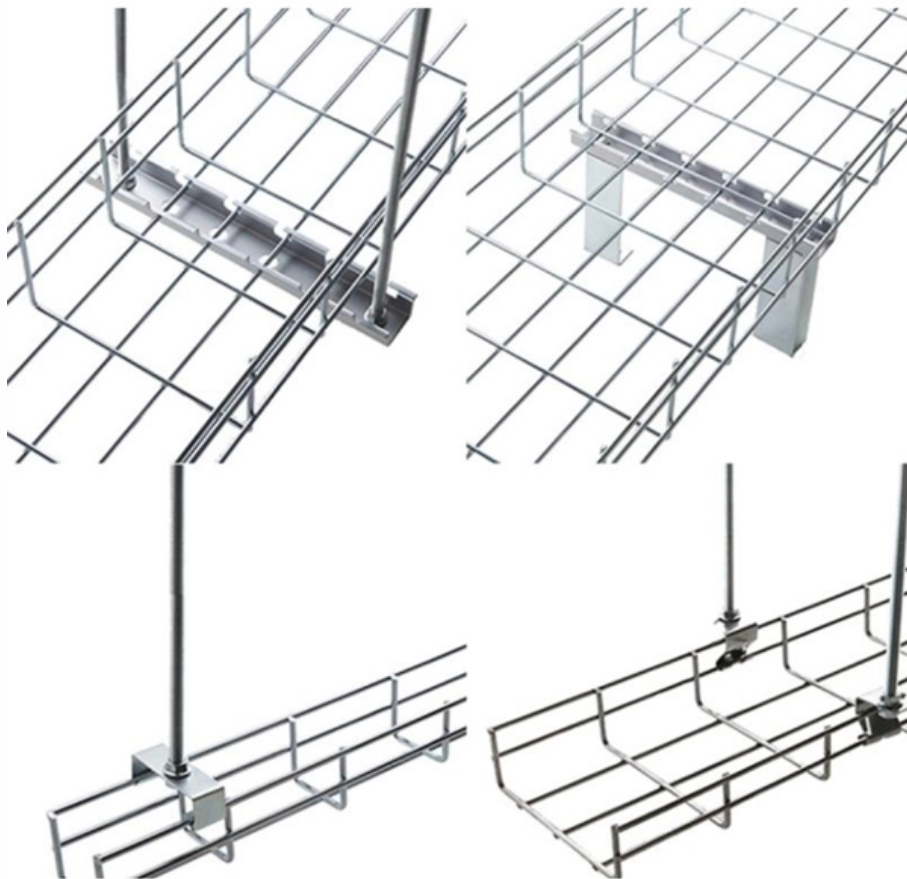


Selection Criteria for Outdoor Optical Cable Pullers





Overview

They must meet classification society requirements (DNV, Lloyd's Register, ABS) for load capacity, material corrosion resistance, and braking performance. Offshore applications additionally require ATEX or IECEx certification if deployed in potentially explosive atmospheres on oil. A cable pull pit (also called a cable pulling chamber or pull box) is an essential component of underground electrical and telecommunication systems. installers should consider bend radius, tension, jamming, and fill ratio before performing any conduit pull. Corning Optical Communications recommends the American Polywater® PULL-PLANNE cable in conduit, observe the manufacturer's recommendations for maximum pulling tension and bend radius.

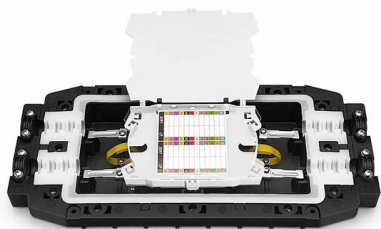
