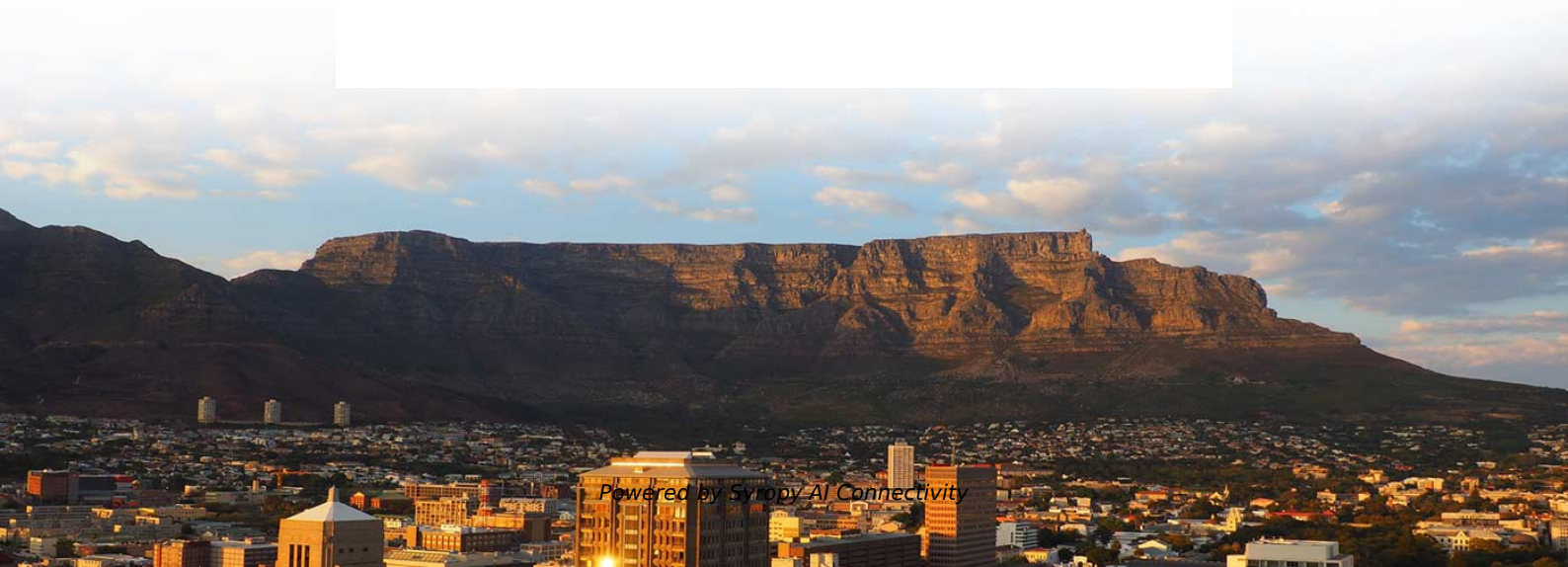

The distribution box (cabinet) is suitable for temporary power supply at the construction site and should meet the requirements of "three-level power distribution, two-level leakage protection, one machine one switch, one leakage one box" for power distribution and protection. These guidelines provide you with information on the installation of electricity mains, services, streetlamps, and other parts of our electricity networks.



Standard Configuration of Level 3 Distribution Boxes on Construction

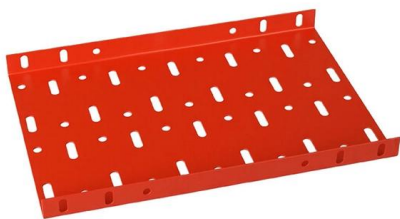
