

Tax burden on fiber optic cable companies





Overview

Fibre tax is now levied by councils as business rates on all broadband network infrastructure in England and Wales. Understanding the tax benefits of extended fibre depreciation can be crucial for businesses looking to optimise their financial strategies.
