Overview

The United Arab Emirates has achieved a new milestone in fiber optic connectivity, recording a fiber-to-the-home penetration rate of 99. Dubai: A series of undersea cable cuts in the Red Sea have significantly slowed down internet access across the Middle East and parts of Asia, including India and Pakistan.
