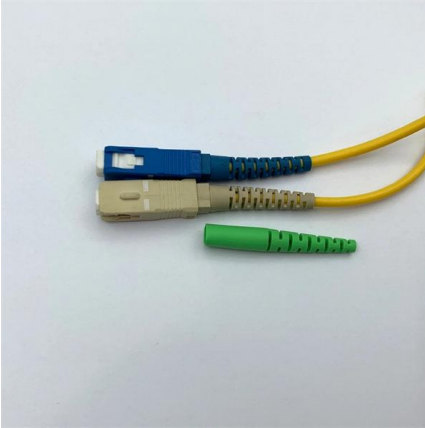


Overview

Tonga Cable System is a submarine fiber-optic cable system connecting Tonga with Fiji, where it connects to other international networks. It has cable landing points at Sopo, a suburb of Nuku'alofa in Tonga . Not a metro area, not a data center cluster — a sovereign nation of roughly 105,000 people, spread across an archipelago of more than 150 islands in the South Pacific, whose international connectivity depends on a. We're working with the Governments of Tonga and New Zealand to build a new international undersea telecommunications cable to Tonga.

Tonga Cable

The Tonga-Fiji Submarine Cable System (also known as Tonga Cable) is a 827km fiber optic submarine cable system linking Nuku'alofa, Tonga and Suva, Fiji, and connects to the Southern Cross Cable

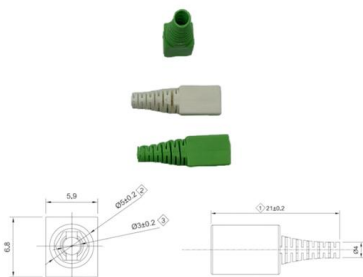
