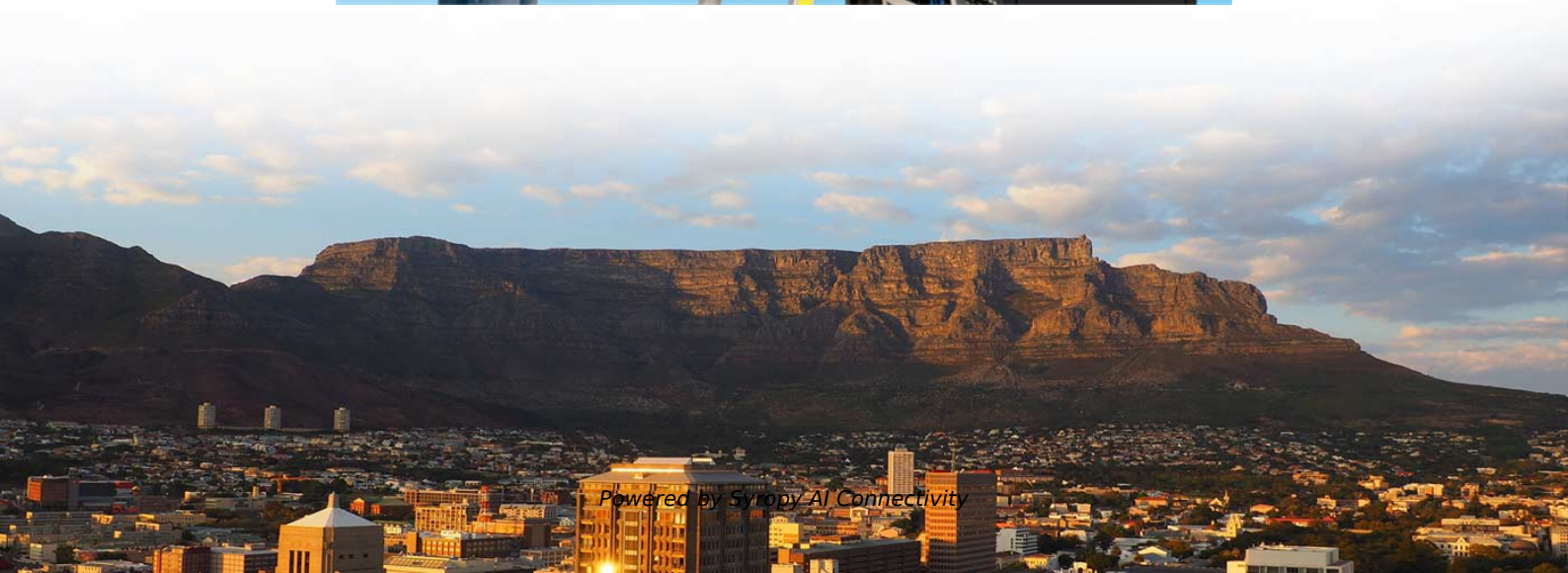

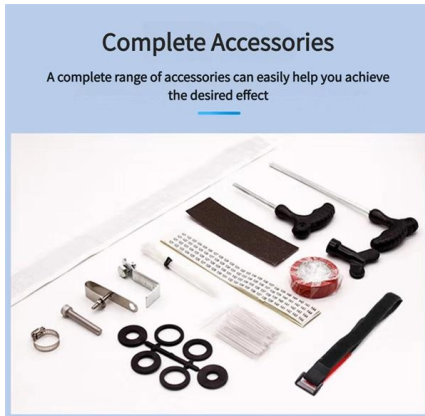


Overview

Pigtail connectors can be categorized by application, connector type, and conductor specifications. Pigtails and Ribbon fanouts, short fiber cuts with connectors on one side, is used for splicing in Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs), Termination Boxes, Cabinets and Enclosures. Common fiber pigtail types include LC, SC, ST, and FC, available in single-mode (OS2) and multimode (OM3/OM4). 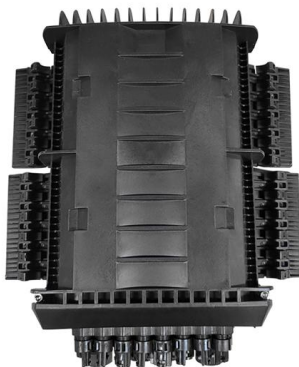
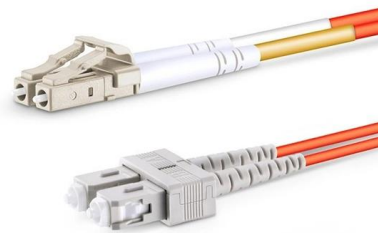

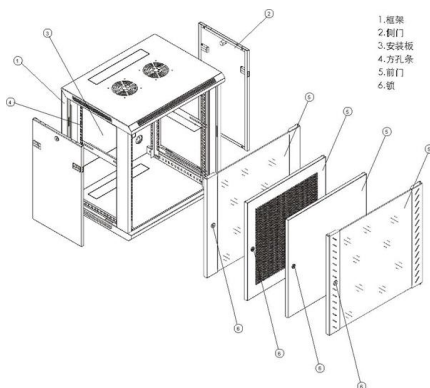
