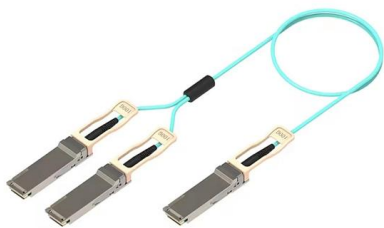
Drilling for Cable

PRO TIP: Drilled holes don't need to be perfectly aligned, but the closer they line up, the easier it is to pull cable through them. If possible, drill holes thigh high 1.
