Overview

What is the composition material of optical fiber connector Mainly PEI, polyetherimide, amber transparent solid, without any addition, it has inherent flame retardancy and low smoke. The core and cladding of most fibers are made of ultra-pure glass, although some fibers are all plastic or a glass core and plastic cladding. The core is designed to have a higher index of refraction, an optical parameter that is a measure of the speed of light in the material, than the cladding. The connectors can be put on patchcords, pigtails or components with single-mode (SM), multi-mode (MM), polarization maintaining (PM), polarized (PZ), Photonic-crystal (PCF), hollow-core (HC) or micro-structured fibers. Such fibers are widely used in fiber-optic communication, where they permit transmission over longer distances and at higher bandwidths (data transfer rates) than. They have a central core surrounded by a concentric cladding with slightly lower (by $\approx 1\%$) refractive index.

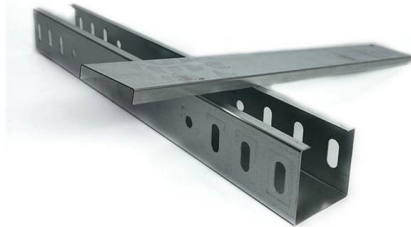
