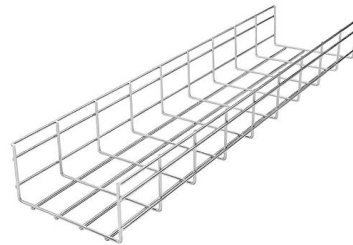


What is the Internal Structure of The Distribution Box

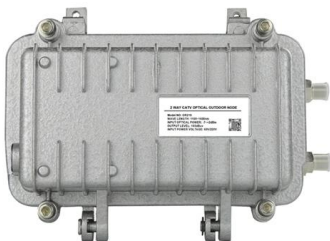
