

Wiring for explosion-proof cabinets





Overview

Let's break it down. Any installation of devices within a hazardous area as defined in the NEC® or ATEX Directive MUST BE in accordance with that device's CONTROL DRAWING and local ordinances. Each workshop has a grounding wire, and the grounding wire of the flammable cabinet is firmly connected to the summary grounding wire of the workshop.
